ALLIANCE Partnership agreement



In June 2020 the ALLIANCE consortium has signed a **Partnership Agreement**. The signing of a partnership agreement was intended to provide the definition of the partnership concept as a result of the the ALLIANCE project and all joint initiatives conducted during the cooperation. **The consortium agreed on continuing the cooperation** to further identify and transfer dual technologies to/from the security & defence sector by interregional and international cooperations, to promote mutually beneficial activities in the sector of European defence and security, advanced materials, notably technical textiles, and connectivity & ICT.

Through this agreement, **partners expressed their interests and plans for engaging in international cluster cooperation together** and commitment to foster the **development of joint initiatives for the internationalization of SMEs**, within the partnership and/or with external stakeholders of interests. The partners will notably work for the implementation and **reinforcement of initiatives with worldwide partners of ALLIANCE** that have signed a memorandum of understanding with the ALLIANCE consortium. The objective is to amplify the long-term impact of international activities and implement a pilot action through original and effective actions based on the ALLIANCE project's outputs.
